Question: According to the European regulation endorsed by the Member

States' committee meeting of 8 December 2008, lamps equivalent in light output to 100 W incandescent bulbs and above have been phased out from the EU market beginning from September 2009. Therefore the reference to 200 W tungsten filament lamps given in

sub-clause 18.2 of EN 60669-1 is not appropriate.

Which type of lamps can be used instead of 200 W tungsten

filament lamps?

**Decision:** 200 W tungsten filament lamps to be used for the test of 18.2 can

be replaced by directional incandescent lamps.

**Explanatory notes:** This OSM/IN decision is based on the decision agreed by CLC/TC

23BX during the 24<sup>th</sup> meeting held in London on June 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>, 2009 (item 11.3, TC23BX/Sec0194/RM). During this meeting CLC/TC 23BX also decided to give the task the Interpretation Panel to prepare an Interpretation Sheet for the

modification of sub-clause 18.2.

This OSM/IN decision remains in force until the above mentioned

Interpretation Sheet will be published.
